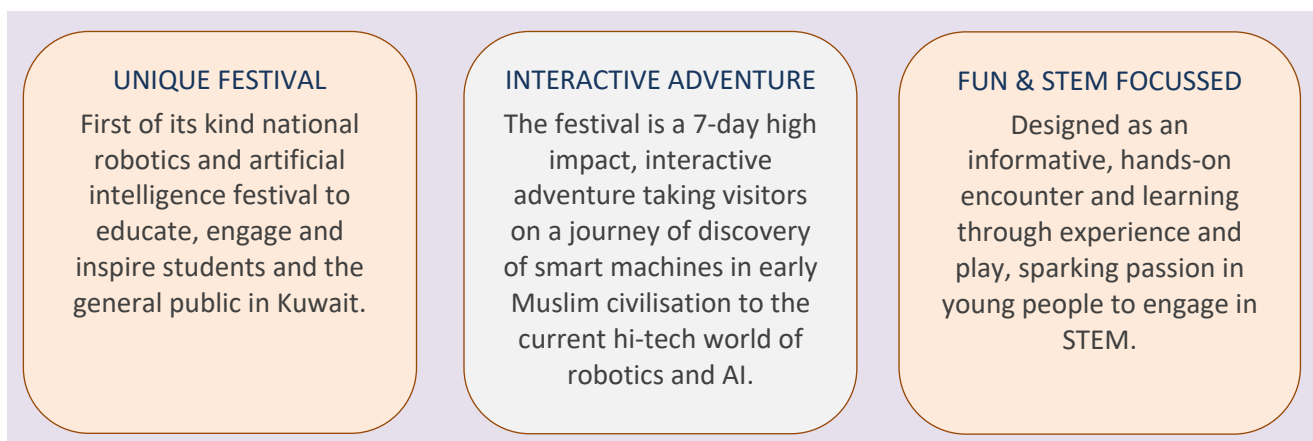

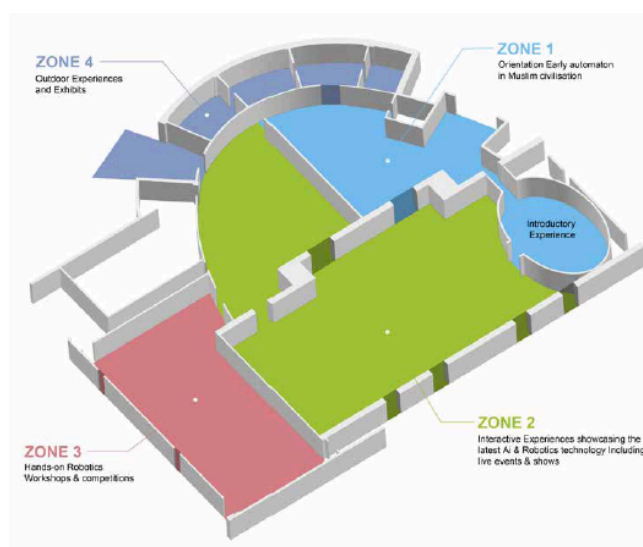
HOW MANY ZONES ARE AT THE FESTIVAL?

Zone 1: Orientation / Live Show. Interactive live show. All visitors must experience and go through the story of robots past present and future. This is where visitors can meet Han, RoboThespian, Teotronico SteamBuster and Banu Musa.

Zone 2: Interactive Experience / The Robots Hall. Visitors meet more robots and engage in robotic demonstrations seeing the talents of Pepper, NAO, iPal, Cozmo and many others.

Zone 3: Workshops Zone. Drop in sessions and workshops for all ages includes coding and other coding based games.

Zone 4: Outdoor Experiences. Robotics Arm VR experience.
